Circadian rhythms or rhythms of biological activity that occur once per day can be found ubiquitously throughout nature. Cyanobacteria are the only prokaryotes known to possess a robust and rigorously tested circadian clock. My lab focuses on understanding the molecular details of the cyanobacterial circadian clock including the subcellular localization of the clock proteins and understanding how the clock is integrated with other cellular processes.
